Mr. Hunt indicated that the regulations were reviewed by the Healthcare committee, and then sent to the LCB without any changes or revisions. Mrs. Shaffer-Kugel noted to the Board that Mrs. Hummel was present to answer any questions. Mrs. Hummel noted to the Board in looking at the actual budget, they are coming in rather close to what they budgeted and what the actual expenses have been. She added that there are some funds that will be available to allocate to their reserves. However, until they reach the end of the fiscal year, she is unable to determine what that amount will be. She noted to the Board that with regards to Infection Control, there is currently no revenue to cover the costs, and that what they budgeted will come fairly close to where they will be at the end of the fiscal year. Mrs. Shaffer-Kugel noted to the Board that they have conducted random audits, which is another item that incurs costs and receives no revenue. She added that she has spoken with Fred Hillerby regarding BDR's that will be introduced at the next legislative session, which will include language that will allow the Board to begin charging for the initial IC inspections. Dr. Miller inquired about the over-budget items in the Statements of Revenues and the balance of funds. He inquired further, on how she projects what the Board's legal fees will be. Mrs. Hummel indicated that it is a difficult assessment because there is no way to know how many complaints will turn into stipulation agreements, which is when they are able to recover investigation and legal fees.

On or before December 31, 2014 payment of \$5,298.33

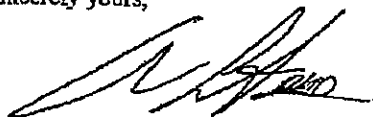

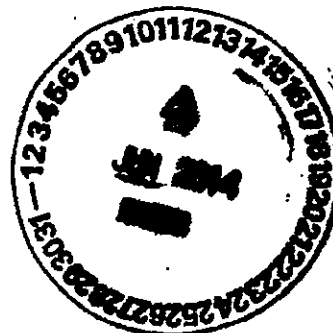

Dear Board Members:

I am writing to ask for an advisory opinion from the Board, regarding our company policy for consent for dental treatment for minors. My goal is to revise our existing policy, such that it will protect the best interest of children, and ensure that our providers are conforming to the legal requirements for the consent of treatment for said children. My providers and I have reviewed the Nevada Revised Statutes Chapter 631, and the Nevada Administrative Codes Chapter 631. We have not been able to clearly define our responsibility, based on the law.

The statutes we are referencing are as follows:

NAC 631.2237 Procedures required before administration of anesthetic or sedation;
This statute says: "If a patient is a minor, the consent must be obtained from his or her parent or legal guardian."

NAC 631.230 Unprofessional conduct. This statute says: "The failure to obtain a patient's written, informed consent before administering general anesthesia, deep sedation or conscious sedation to the patient or, if the patient is a minor, the failure to obtain his or her parent's or guardian's consent unless the dentist determines that an emergency situation exists in which delaying the procedure to obtain the consent would likely cause permanent injury to the patient."

Parental Consent for Dental Treatment of a Minor**

Initial Visit/ Recall Visit/ True Emergency Visit:

- 1) Any minor, (any person under the age of 18) will need to be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian in order to be seen by a Dentist in the clinic for an initial visit or recall visit. Exceptions are listed below and proper documentation is mandatory with no exceptions:
 - a. Any adult family member or temporary caretaker with a written notarized consent affidavit (typed or written note) from a parent or legal guardian will be accepted to ensure a minor can be seen in the clinic for an examination (which includes x-rays) for diagnosis of dental needs.
 - b. Any person appointed or granted by a court to consent medical or dental treatment of a minor is acceptable. Proper Court documentation is mandatory before examination can be completed.
 - c. Any Emancipated Minor shall be considered an adult for the purpose of consent to any dental examination or procedure as long as the minor has received a "declaration of emancipation" from the court. Documentation is as follows:
 - i. Provide a copy of emancipation decree and/or
 - ii. Completed MR1.07Fc Documentation of Self-Sufficient Minor Status
 - d. Any emergency situation where immediate intervention is warranted due to trauma or any other truly emergent condition. This decision should be made by the attending Dentist.
 - i. Patient can be examined
 - ii. Patient may receive treatment if the attending doctor feels treatment is warranted and necessary. This can be done without parental consent, but a call to the parent or legal guardian will be attempted.
 - iii. The documentation in the minor's chart should adequately describe the situation.

Treatment Appointment: Minor without Accompanied Caretaker

- 1) Any adult acting as a temporary caretaker with a written notarized consent affidavit (typed or written note) from a parent or legal guardian will be accepted to ensure the minor can be seen for treatment in the clinic:
 - a. Any treatment will need to be authorized by the parent or legal guardian with at least a signed copy of the minors' treatment plan before ANY treatment can begin.
 - i. If an adult temporary caretaker is accompanying a minor for treatment, a phone call to the parent or legal guardian should be attempted and recorded in chart before treatment begins.
 - ii. Note: Attending Dentist has the right to require parent or legal guardian supervision at any appointment they feel may require more consent than the treatment plan describes. This notification will happen before an appointment to assure compliance from Parent/Guardian and to mitigate rescheduling.
- 2) Any adult with a written notarized consent affidavit (typed or written note) from a parent or legal guardian will need to remain at the facility while treatment is being conducted. A minor may **not** be dropped off for treatment.

We do not need to obtain a Parental Consent if the following applies:

- 2) An emergency situation where immediate intervention is warranted due to trauma or any other truly emergent condition. This decision should be made by the attending Dentist.
 - i. Patient can be examined
 - ii. Patient may receive treatment if the attending doctor feels treatment is warranted and necessary. This can be done without parental consent, but a call to the parent or legal guardian will be attempted.
 - iii. The documentation in the minor's chart should adequately describe the situation.
- 3) Parent is accompanying the child.
- 4) Legal Guardian is accompanying the child.
 - i. Must have legal documentation in chart of legal guardianship.
 - ii. Legal guardian must sign financial agreement.
- 5) The minor is emancipated.
 - i. Provide a copy of emancipation decree and/or
 - ii. Completed MR1.07Fc Documentation of Self-Sufficient Minor Status

RE: Veterans Licensure Reciprocity and Data efforts

I. BACKGROUND

- On January 6, 2014, Governor Sandoval proclaimed 2014 to be the "Year of the Veteran" in Nevada. The goals of this proclamation were to focus as many services and service providers in the state as possible on the challenges facing veterans, to develop and implement best practices for addressing those challenges, and, by the end of the year, to make Nevada the most veteran- and military-friendly state in the country. Because of the anticipated end of deployments to Afghanistan, and the coming military drawdown, 2014 is a crucial year for Nevada to meet these goals.
- The "Year of the Veteran" concept is built upon several years of work towards marshalling all available resources to service members, veterans, and their families under the Green Zone Initiative (GZI). The GZI is a statewide strategic plan focused on the three areas of Wellness, Education, and Employment, and it is also a collaboration architecture aimed at building local coalitions and coordinating them throughout the state.

II. CURRENT SITUATION

- Within the Employment focus area of the GZI, the Governor has developed several efforts, one of which is an effort to reduce barriers to entry for service members, veterans, and their families. These efforts are based on the fact that many service members and veterans have considerable skills, talents, and extensive training, much of which can be recognized as official experience and training with respect to transition into civilian licensure and employment.
- The Governor's first major action toward this goal was signing Executive Order 2012-11, which provided for reciprocity for military spouses seeking licensure within Nevada.
- In 2013, the Office of the Governor received a Policy Academy grant from the National Governor's Association to help reduce veteran unemployment through increasing licensure reciprocity opportunities for veterans, either through bridge programs, challenge opportunities, or other forms of reciprocity. The grant is focused on developing opportunities in the fields of Emergency Medical Services, Licensed Practical Nurses, and Law Enforcement.

- In May of 2014, Governor Sandoval signed Executive Order 2014-11, requiring the professional licensing bodies in each of these fields to establish reciprocity opportunities that made sense within their field. The order also requires each to develop appropriate questions to add to renewal and licensure applications to better capture the number of service members and veterans holding license or seeking licensure in Nevada and to report that information in aggregate to the Nevada Department of Veterans Services.

III. GOING FORWARD

- Following the completion of the Policy Academy grant from the National Governor's Association, there is a clear desire to extend these opportunities to other licensed fields as well.
- In their May 2014 report to Governor Sandoval, the Interagency Council on Veterans Affairs made several recommendations regarding licensure reciprocity to be considered ahead of the next Legislative Session. First, that the state should pass legislation that would "provide a general requirement for state licensing boards and bodies to develop licensure reciprocity opportunities for service members, veterans, and their families holding federal licenses that are not currently recognized by the State of Nevada." Second, that the state should pass legislation that would require licensing bodies in Nevada to capture and share aggregate data regarding the number of veterans seeking and/or receiving licensure or renewal and share that information with the Nevada Department of Veterans Services and the Interagency Council on Veterans Affairs on an annual basis.
