63 *3. Public Workshop: (For Possible Action)

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65 *Notice of Public Workshop, Request for Comments and Consideration of Recommendations from the Anesthesia
66 Resource Group for proposed regulation changes and/or amendments pertaining to Nevada Administrative Code
67 Chapter 631. The general topics include the following;

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69 Mrs. Shaffer-Kugel indicated that the Board appointed an Anesthesia subcommittee to review the proposed
70 regulation changes, which were sent for consideration and review to the Anesthesia committee. Upon review of
71 the Anesthesia committee, the regulations presented are the changes, if any, being proposed for consideration and
72 approval.

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74 1) NAC 631.003-Sedation Defined

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76 MOTION: Ms. Tyler made the motion to approve the proposed changes to NAC 613.003. Motion was seconded by
77 Dr. Sanders. All were in favor of the motion.

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79 2) NAC 631.004-Sedation Permits

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81 Mrs. Shaffer-Kugel stated that the committee was proposing the addition of a Pediatric Moderate sedation permit.
82 She explained the requirements for this permit, as stated in the regulation proposed. She noted that those whom
83 currently hold a conscious sedation permit will be grandfathered in.

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85 MOTION: Dr. Pisani made the motion to approve the proposed changes to NAC 613.004. Motion was seconded by
86 Ms. Gabriel. All were in favor of the motion.

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88 3) NAC 631.029-Schedule of Fees

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90 Mrs. Shaffer-Kugel stated that the only fiscal impact, if any, would be to anyone that would be applying for the
91 permits in the future. She noted that some of the changes were verbiage changes and the addition of fees for
92 pediatric site permit and for a pediatric moderate permit fee.

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94 MOTION: Dr. Sanders made the motion to approve the proposed changes to NAC 613.029. Motion was seconded
95 by Dr. Blasco. All were in favor of the motion.

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97 4) NAC 631.2211-Scope

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99 Mrs. Shaffer-Kugel when breaking out conscious sedation to minimal and moderate sedation, the committee opted
100 to not require that a licensee hold an administrator or site permit for minimal sedation so long as the licensees stay
101 within the parameters presented.

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103 MOTION: Dr. Pisani made the motion to approve the proposed changes to NAC 613.2211. Motion was seconded
104 by Dr. Champagne. Discussion: Dr. Blasco noted that in the 5th line of the proposed regulation, that the last word
105 be changed to "be" and not "he". Dr. Pisani amended his motion to note the changes made by Dr. Blasco. Dr.
106 Champagne agreed to the changes as the second to the motion. All were in favor of the motion.

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108 5) NAC 631.2213-Permit required, qualification of applicant

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110 Mrs. Shaffer-Kugel stated that the moderate sedation education requirements (previously known as conscious
111 sedation) do have any extensive changes to it. She went over the proposed changes that would apply to pediatric
112 moderate permits, to include, the age of the patient and the educational requirements. Dr. Sanders added that some
113 Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons are assumed to have met the requirements, which they would be permitted to
114 administer to patients of any age, including pediatrics.

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116 MOTION: Dr. Pisani made the motion to approve the proposed changes to NAC 613.2213. Motion was seconded
117 by Dr. Champagne. All were in favor of the motion.

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119 6) NAC 631.2217-Review of holder of permit

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121 Mrs. Shaffer-Kugel went over the proposed regulation and the proposed changes.
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123 MOTION: Dr. Sanders made the motion to approve the proposed changes to NAC 613.2217. Motion was seconded
124 by Dr. Pisani. All were in favor of the motion.
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126 7) NAC 631.2219-Inspection and evaluation; reevaluation

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142 Mrs. Shaffer-Kugel noted to the Board that the changes made were to bring the language current.
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144 MOTION: Dr. Pisani made the motion to approve the proposed changes to NAC 613.2223. Motion was seconded
145 by Ms. Gabriel. All were in favor of the motion.
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147 10) NAC 631.2225-Inspection and evaluations; Simulated emergencies
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149 Mrs. Shaffer-Kugel briefly went over the proposed changes.
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151 MOTION: Dr. Blasco made the motion to approve the proposed changes to NAC 631.2225. Motion was seconded
152 by Dr. Pisani. All were in favor of the motion.
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154 11) NAC 631.2227-Inspections and evaluation; general anesthesia ; deep sedation –Physical facilities and
155 equipment

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159 MOTION: Dr. Pisani made the motion to approve proposed changes to NAC 631.2227. Motion was seconded by
160 Dr. Shahrestani. All were in favor of the motion.
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162 12) NAC 631.2229-Inspection and evaluations; Records of patients
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164 Mrs. Shaffer-Kugel briefly went over proposed regulation.
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166 MOTION: Dr. Sanders made the motion to approve the proposed changes to NAC 631.2229. Motion was seconded
167 by Dr. Shahrestani. All were in favor of the motion.
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169 13) NAC 631.2231-Inspections and evaluations; general anesthesia; deep sedation; Emergency drugs
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171 Mrs. Shaffer-Kugel briefly went over proposed regulation.
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173 MOTION: Dr. Pisani made the motion to approve proposed changes to NAC 631.2231. Motion was seconded by
174 Dr. Sanders. All were in favor of the motion.
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176 14) NAC 631.2233- Inspections and evaluations; Recommendations of inspectors or evaluators

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Mrs. Shaffer-Kugel briefly went over the proposed regulation.

MOTION: Ms. Gabriel made the motion to approve the proposed changes to NAC 631.2233. Motion was seconded by Ms. Tyler. All were in favor of the motion.

15) NAC 631.2235-Inspections and evaluations; Failure to pass; request for reevaluation

Mrs. Shaffer-Kugel briefly went over the proposed regulation.

MOTION: Dr. Blasco made the motion to approve the proposed changes to NAC 631.2235. Motion was seconded by Ms. Gabriel. All were in favor of the motion.

16) NAC 631.2236-Certificate of Site approval; General requirements

Mrs. Shaffer-Kugel briefly went over the proposed regulation.

MOTION: Dr. Pinther made the motion to approve the proposed changes to NAC 631.2236. Motion was seconded by Dr. Blasco. All were in favor of the motion.

17) NAC 631.2237-Procedures required before administration of anesthesia or sedation

Mrs. Shaffer-Kugel briefly went over the proposed regulation.

MOTION: Dr. Sanders made the motion to approve the proposed changes to NAC 631.2237. Motion was seconded by Ms. Gabriel. All were in favor of the motion.

18) NAC 631.2239-Properly equipped facility required; qualifications of auxiliary personnel

Mrs. Shaffer-Kugel briefly went over the proposed regulation.

MOTION: Dr. Pisani made the motion to approve the proposed changes to NAC 631.2239. Motion was seconded by Ms. Gabriel. All were in favor of the motion.

19) NAC 631.224-Employment of certified registered nurse anesthetist

Mrs. Shaffer-Kugel briefly went over the proposed regulation.

MOTION: Ms. Tyler made the motion to approve the proposed changes to NAC 631.224. Motion was seconded by Dr. Pisani. All were in favor of the motion.

20) NAC 631.2241-Report of injuries to patients

Mrs. Shaffer-Kugel briefly went over the proposed regulation.

MOTION: Dr. Blasco made the motion to approve the proposed changes to NAC 631.2241. Motion was seconded by Dr. Shahrestani. All were in favor of the motion.

21) NAC 631.2254- Temporary permits

Mrs. Shaffer-Kugel briefly went over the proposed regulation.

MOTION: Dr. Blasco made the motion to approve the proposed changes to NAC 631.2254. Motion was seconded by Ms. Gabriel. All were in favor of the motion.

22) NAC 631.2256-Continuing education required

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Mrs. Shaffer-Kugel briefly went over the proposed regulation.

MOTION: Dr. Pisani made the motion to approve the proposed changes to NAC 631.2256. Motion was seconded by Dr. Sanders. Discussion: Dr. Blasco inquired on the reasoning behind the increase in number of hours required. Dr. Johnson replied that the committee did not believe it would be unreasonable to require 6 hours of related courses to general anesthesia to ensure that permit holders stay abreast of the ever changing drugs being developed. All were in favor of the motion.

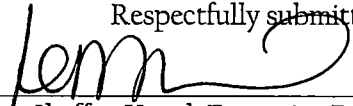
