Licenses to Permanent Licenses Available OnlineDate:July 28, 2022

Per our Memo dated July 14, 2022, the Nevada State Board of Dental Examiners voted to approve the CDCA-WREB compedent/manikin exam for the restorative and periodontal section for dental and hygiene exams for licensure on July 12, 2022.

As stated in the July 14th Memo, a licensee who possesses a Temporary Restricted and/or Unrestricted License will no longer need to take a patient-based clinical examination to convert their Temporary License to a Permanent License. However, the conversion will **not** be automatic. It is incumbent upon the licensee to timely submit the appropriate application and documentation to the Board to request conversion of the Temporary Restricted and/or Unrestricted License to a Permanent License no later than the **June 30, 2023** deadline proscribed in the May 25, 2022 Memorandum.

To this end, please note that new application forms for conversion of Temporary Restricted and Unrestricted Licenses to Permanent Licenses are now available online on the Nevada State Board of Dental Examiners' website at <u>www.dental.nv.gov</u>.
