From: Nevada State Board of Dental Examiners  
Re: Approval of the CDCA-WREB Compedont/Manikin Exam for Restorative and Periodontal Section for Dental and Hygiene Exams  
Date: **July 14, 2022**

At its July 12, 2022 meeting, the Nevada State Board of Dental Examiners voted to approve the CDCA-WREB compedont/manikin exam for the restorative and periodontal section for dental and hygiene exams for licensure.

Please note, this directive supersedes the previous Memoranda issued on September 18, 2020 and May 25, 2022 which required the successful completion of patient-based clinical examination in order for the Temporary Restricted and/or Unrestricted License to be converted to a Permanent License prior to the expiration of the June 30, 2023 deadline.

Therefore, any licensee who possesses a Temporary Restricted and/or Unrestricted License will no longer need to take a patient-based clinical examination to convert their Temporary License to a Permanent License. However, the conversion will **not** be automatic. It is incumbent upon the licensee to timely submit the appropriate application and documentation to the Board to request conversion of the Temporary Restricted and/or Unrestricted License to a Permanent License no later than the **June 30, 2023** deadline proscribed in the May 25, 2022 Memorandum.

In the interim, the Board will continue to issue new Temporary Licenses from **June 30, 2022 – November 30, 2022**.
