## \*3. Chairwoman's Report: Elizabeth Park, DDS (For Possible Action)

Dr. Park turned the floor over to Ms. Solie for comment.

Ms. Solie thanked everyone for the ongoing process and advised everyone that they are not here to make policy, they are just there to gather thoughts from the stakeholders and expert advice and opinions from those that have experience as well as the committee and subcommittee. Those considerations will be put together by the committee as we move a draft forward. The committee wants to make sure they do their due diligence so that the regulations that come forward are the gold standard as we meet the intentions and purpose of the legislation.

Dr. Park stated that if any member of the committee or subcommittee feels unheard, you have an opportunity to present your concerns in a workshop session which the Board will hold after this. There is due process. Dr. Park read an email statement from Ms. Bordelove regarding NRS 281A.420 public officers/employees disclosure.

  - NRS 631.3124 Dental Therapists: Authorized services; referral of patient to authorizing dentist for certain purposes; supervision of dental assistants and dental hygienists.

Ms. Arias was assigned to this agenda item.

- o NRS 631.3125 Dental therapists: Additional authorized care and services.
  - NRS 631.3125(1-9): Point of discussion:
    - NPI and Insurance; Direct or Indirect Supervision

Ms. Taylor was assigned to this agenda item.

- NRS 631.3125(10): Point of discussion:
  - Preparation and placement of direct restoration in primary and permanent teeth
- Dr. Saxe was assigned this agenda item.

  - NRS 631.215 Persons deemed to be practicing dentistry; regulations regarding clinical practice of dentistry. (Amended by SB 366(2019))

- Dr. Saxe stated that the Nevada law states that any person that works in a dental office must wear a name tag. He feels that if the person holds a degree that it should appear on the name tag and it should be displayed on the door or wall like a business license.
- Dr. Park agrees and has taken this agenda item.
- Dr. West suggested that on the introductory forms that it could state that the patient may be seen by a dental therapist that is being supervised by an overseeing dentist and the patient would therefore sign that they acknowledge this prior to being seen.
- Dr. West will collaborate with Dr, Park on this agenda item.
  - NRS 631.271 Limited license to practice dentistry, dental hygiene or dental therapy; permit authorizing certain persons to practice dentistry or dental hygiene; regulations. (Amended by SB 366(2019))

      - Malpractice and termination of written contract with dentistry program;
      - Board to be provided documentation within seven days of termination of contract

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There was live public comment from Gail Baker Clark, RDH, she has practice in Nevada and Pennsylvania.
