Dr. Lemon stated that there were some concerns regarding the clinical portion of the Dental Laser Coaching course, namely, who would be conducting hands-on demonstration.

Dr. Park inquired as to whether there were any additional proctors on the paperwork.

Ms. Arias noted that hygienists can be included in the course.

- Ms. Arias inquired whether there were any secondary providers ready to stand in if Dr. Leavitt became unavailable.
- Mr. Clausen noted that although he did not have any firm secondary providers, he has a list of other practitioners whom he could reach out to stand in for Dr. Leavitt if necessary.
- Dr. Park thanked Mr. Clausen for the clarification and for compiling the list of practitioners for the course.
- Dr. Moore noted that when the Committee recommends the Board approve the course, Mr. Clausen would need to be ready to notify the Board of any changes in clinical demonstrators and would need to update the paperwork accordingly.
- Dr. Moore renewed the motion to recommend approval of the course to the Board. Ms. Arias seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion passed.
