*a. <u>Discussion and Possible Recommendations by the Infection Control Committee to the Full</u> <u>Board Regarding Proposed Adjustments to the Training Program for Infection Control Inspectors</u> <u>and Revisions to the Infection Control Survey Form Prepared by Marie T Fluent, DDS</u> (For Possible Action)

Dr. Park introduced the foregoing agenda item and briefly described the context and history of the
proposed drafts from Ms. Fluent. Mr. Su made a note of the materials included within the Books, and a
brief discussion ensued between Dr. Park and Mr. Su.

Dr. Park opened the floor for comments and suggestions by Committee members. Dr. Lemon

- commented on his review of the materials and mentioned a few changes he would like to see made to the drafts, and noted that areas on the form could be consolidated and updated.
- There was discussion between Dr. Park and Dr. Lemon regarding the drafts, and they agreed it would be helpful to hear from the inspectors who use the form as well as the licensees who undergo inspections and evaluations. Dr. Park asked Ms. Spilsbury for information regarding inspections conducted especially
- 61 in light of COVID-19, and brief discussion was held among Ms. Spilsbury, Dr. Park, and Dr. Lemon.

Mr. Su provided a page-by-page overview of the proposed draft forms as well as suggested changes,

2 and Dr. Park made additional notes for Ms. Fluent regarding edits. Dr. Park then requested the Committee 3 to offer additional insight if they wished to do so. Dr. York and Ms. Petrilla noted that they agreed with Dr. 4 Lemon's earlier comments. 5 6

Dr. Park and Mr. Su opened for comments by inspectors attending the meeting. Ms. Sturges outlined her recommendations based on experience she has gained as an inspector.

Dr. Park noted that it would be helpful to have a greater number of inspectors present at the next meeting in order to offer their recommendations, as well as to have Dr. Fluent present in order to discuss the drafts.
