- Vision – To champion optimal safety in the oral health care delivery system to protect the health and well-being of patients and their providers



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Programming For Safety

Program Element	Description and Timeline
Safety Symposium	A symposium on safety in pediatric dental practice was held in November 2019, bringing experts in industrial, medical and dental safety together
Safety On-Line Toolkit	Near completion, this on-line resource provides resources and guidance for members related to all aspects of safety practice and culture
COVID-19 Website/Town Halls	This resource apprised membership of emerging issues related to the pandemic, through the AAPD website and Town Hall meetings
Practice Emergence Checklist	This roadmap led practices back from isolation with guidance on how to restore practice with safe physical, human, and procedural information
AAAASF Collaboration	This relationship encourages pediatric dentists to advance their practices to a certified level of safety based on established safety standards
Liaisons	Added ABPD member to Safety Committee and added representatives from councils and districts
Adding Safety to Communications	Safety to appear in electronic and paper communication regularly



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2019 AAPD Safety Symposium


- Brought safety to the membership in 1.5 days
- Representatives from Medicine, Space, Risk Management, Sedation, Continuous Quality Improvement, and Safety Culture spoke

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American Association For Accreditation Of Ambulatory Surgery Facilities(AAASF)

- Patient Safety
- General Anesthesia and deep sedation are increasingly transitioning into dental offices as operating room access is becoming more limited.
- Practitioners and the public are becoming increasingly more demanding to demonstrate safety by independent facility accreditation.
- Collaborative accreditation process developed for pediatric dentistry.



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AAAASF Collaboration

- Voluntary accreditation-strongly encouraged
- Movement by state regulatory bodies for offices that provide deep sedation and GA to be independently accredited

AAPD & AAAASF have partnered to offer an accreditation program for pediatric dental practices. AAPD encourages offices to become accredited.



Together we look forward to being the driving force for pediatric dental patient safety worldwide and demonstrating to patient families our unwavering dedication to the safety of their children.

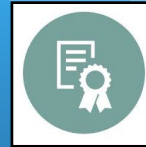


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Why does the AAPD think accreditation is important?

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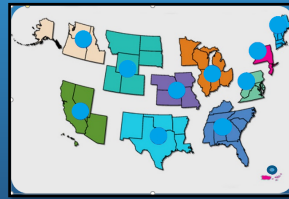
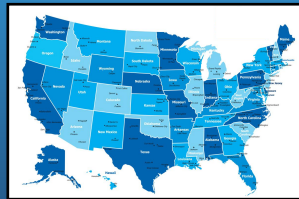
