1. Call to Order

Committee Chair Dr. Lemon called the meeting to order at approximately 6:04 p.m. Mr. Dworin conducted roll call. Quorum was met.

2. Public Comment (By pre-submitted email/written form only): The public comment period is limited to matters specifically noticed on the agenda. *3. Chairman's Report: Ronald Lemon, DDS (For Possible Action)

Dr. Lemon provided some background on the Continuing Education Committee. Many of the continuing education course applications received are renewals of existing courses that the Board has previously approved and which can be approved by the Chairperson without calling a Committee meeting. Occasionally there are applications that have significant questions that need to be answered by the Committee or courses that are beyond the scope of expertise of the Chairperson. In those cases, the Committee needs to meet to ensure that the course meets the standards for approval in the state of Nevada.

There was no request to remove agenda items.

*b. <u>Approve Agenda</u> (For Possible Action)

Dr. Lemon made a motion to approve the agenda. All were in favor. Motion passed.

- *4. New Business: (For Possible Action)
 - *a. <u>Discussion, consideration, and possible recommendations to the Board regarding</u>

 approval/rejection of Laser Proficiency Program NAC 631.033 & NAC 631.035 (For Possible Action)
 - (1) Er Cr YSGG All Tissue Laser Training (8 units) Michael K Koceja, DDS

Dr. Lemon introduced the agenda item. Dr. Koceja was present as an attendee and was invited to speak. He provided an overview of the general laser course on the YSGG laser. The course is offered primarily to those who purchase the laser so they can use it safely and proficiently. Dr. Lemon clarified that Dr. Koceja is a full-time employee of Biolase. Dr. Lemon voiced concern that there was no disclosure statement regarding Dr. Koceja's financial relationship with Biolase. He requested that changes be made to include a financial

disclosure statement both in advertisements for the course and at the beginning of the presentation. Dr. Lemon asked whether Dr. Koceja was a member of the Academy of Laser Dentistry (ALD) Speaker Bureau. Dr. Koceja responded that he is not listed as a member of the ALD Speaker Bureau, however he has completed the proficiency course. Dr. Lemon opened the floor to comments by Committee members There was discussion between Dr. Lemon and Ms. Arias regarding whether Dr. Koceja is required to be licensed in Nevada and should be a member of the ALD. Dr. Lemon stated that it is preferable for a course that has been approved by the American Dental Association Continuing Education Recognition Program (ADA CERP), it is not necessary. Dr. Koceja stated that he has been approved by the Academy of General Dentisty's Program Approval for Continuing Education (AGD, PACE), and has been teaching similar courses throughout the country for the past 12 years. He has been approved to teach diode classes in Nevada for the past 14 years. Dr. Lemon was satisfied with the didactic portion of the laser course but requested further information regarding the methodologies and specimen used to teach the hands-on portion. Dr. Koceja responded that pig jaw is utilized for soft tissue and a demonstration of osseous cutting, as well as the use of laser for disinfection. The two instructors, Dr. Koceja and Dr. Bradley Labrecque, are both licensed dentists, fulfilling the requirement for Nevada. Dr. Lemon stated the only required improvement he has for approval is inclusion of a financial disclosure to be presented during advertisement and at the beginning of the course so participants have a clear understanding of the relationship the instructors have with Biolase. Ms. Arias asked if Dr. Labrecque is also employed by Biolase; Dr. Koceja confirmed Dr. Labrecque's employment with Biolase and intent to include a financial disclosure statement for Dr. Labrecque as well.

Dr. Lemon entertained a motion to make a recommendation to the Board on approval or rejection or tabling of the Laser Course Application with revisions. Dr. Johl made a motion to approve the course with the aforementioned recommendations by Dr. Lemon. Ms. Arias seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion passed. The Committee will forward a recommendation to the full Board for approval with the stipulation of including disclosure statements.
