The Board discussed the approval of the Puerto Rico Maxi course program and clinical residency in implant dentistry as a moderate sedation course. Concerns were raised about the lack of information regarding didactic hours, the format of lectures, and verification of case completions. Dr. Branco and Dr. West decided to table this decision until the Board can review further information from the applicant.

- (1) Dr. Branco reviewed Dr. Weber's application for temporary anesthesia permit and confirmed that the application was complete. Dr. Branco made a motion to approve the application for Dr. Weber. Dr. West seconded the motion and the motion passed.

- (2) Dr. Branco and Dr. West discussed Dr. Heinl's pending course completion. Mark Karris informed the Board that the approval of Dr. Heinl's must be tabled until the course is completed. Dr. Branco made the motion to table the agenda item until the course is completed. Dr. West seconded the motion and the motion passed.
