Dr. Branco introduced the program presented by Amber Juliano, RDH. Ms. Arias and other members expressed other concerns about the program's infection control measures, particularly regarding the use of disposable materials and the lack of description on how the instruments are disinfected. Ms. Petrilla and Ms. McIntyre also raised concerns about the program's ability to perform proper prophylaxis without scalers and the implications for billing to Medicaid. Ms. Arias suggested tabling the item until the applicant is present to address these concerns. Ms. Arias made a motion to table the item, which is seconded by Ms. McIntyre. The motion passed unanimously.
