- \*3. Chairman's Report: Joshua Branco, DMD (For Possible Action)
  - \*a. Request to Remove Agenda Item(s) (For Possible Action)

Dr. Branco made a motion to approve the agenda with no changes. Dr. West seconded the motion and the motion passed.

- \*4. Old Business: (For Possible Action)
  - \*a. <u>Discussion and Consideration of Potential Recommendations of the Anesthesia Committee to Full Board Regarding Possible Revisions to Regulations Governing Inspections/Evaluations for Issuing and/or Renewing Anesthesia Permits and Required Maintenance of Emergency Drugs NRS 631.190, NRS 631.265, NAC 631.2227 and NAC 631.2231 (For Possible Action)</u>

The committee discussed potential revisions to regulations for anesthesia permits and emergency drug requirements. Dr. Sachs noted that the changes were discussed and approved in a public workshop years ago but had not advanced to the legislature. Dr. Okundaye emphasized keeping a five-year inspection requirement while allowing flexibility for re-inspections. Dr. Sachs supported adding drug expiration date tracking and maintaining minimum sedation cases per year. Dr. West moved to recommend interim changes to the Board regarding the NACs, while further evaluations continue. Dr. Branco seconded the motion and all were in favor. The motion passed.

- \*5. New Business: (For Possible Action)
  - \*a. Discussion, Consideration, and Possible Recommendation to the Board to Approve or Deny The Vesper Institute as a Moderate Sedation Board Approved Course of Study and to Specifically Address Whether Such Course is for Patients 13 years of Age or Older NRS 631.190 & NAC 631.2213 (For possible action.)
  - a) Dr. Okundaye raised concerns about the course not meeting the state's requirements for live didactic hours and questioned the inclusion of general anesthesia drugs in the curriculum. Dr.

Resnick from Vesper Institute explained their training, which includes both online modules and in-person sessions, emphasizing the comprehensive nature of the program. The committee decided to table the decision, forwarding it to the full board for further discussion without a formal recommendation.

- \*b. <u>Discussion, Consideration, and Possible Recommendation to the Board Regarding the Hiring of the Following as Part-Time On-Site Evaluator/Inspector Employees</u>

  NRS 631.190, NAC 631.2221 (For Possible Action)
  - (1) Lee E Roundy, DMD Pediatric Moderate Sedation
  - (2) Jeff E Moxley, DD General Anesthesia
- 1) Dr. Branco moved to approve Dr. Roundy as an inspector and Dr. West seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
- 2) Dr. Branco moved to approve Dr. Moxley as an inspector and Dr. Hock seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
- \*c. <u>Discussion</u>, Consideration, and Possible Recommendation to the Board to Approve or Deny The Miami Valley Hospital "Medical Emergencies, Local Anesthesia and Moderate Sedation in Dental Practice." Dentistry as a Moderate Sedation Board Approved Course of Study and to Specifically Address Whether Such Course is for patients 13 years of Age or Older NRS 631.190 & NAC 631.2213 (For possible action.
- c) Dr. Okundaye noted discrepancies in the course's advertised hours and concerns about general anesthesia training. Steve Shufflebarger from Miami Valley Hospital clarified that recent updates to the course met the 60 hours of in-person didactics requirement and removed ACLS from the curriculum. The committee requested updated materials before making a decision. The matter was tabled for further review.
  - \*d. Approval/Rejection of Temporary Anesthesia Permit NAC 631.2254 (For Possible Action)
    - (1) Creed S Haymond, DDS General Anesthesia

Dr. Branco moved to approve the temporary anesthesia permit for Dr. Haymond. Dr. West seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Dr. Heinel, a student in the Miami Valley Hospital moderate sedation program, stated that he has taken extensive training and is looking for the best possible programs to protect patient safety. Dr. Heinel expressed that the Miami Valley Hospital program, led by Drs. Becker and Shufflebarger, is very professional and strict, and Dr. Heinel has seen students fail who did not demonstrate proper aptitude.
