Dr. Lee made a motion to approve the agenda. Dr. Johl seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion passed.

 - *a. <u>Discussion, Consideration, Review and Possible Approval of Transfer of Board Banking Accounts</u>
 <u>to New Banking Institution. NRS 631.190</u> (For Possible Action)

The main discussion focused on transferring the board's banking accounts from Wells Fargo to Nevada State Bank. Adam Higgenbotham explained the transition process, highlighting the benefits of improved customer service and potential cost savings. Dr. Joel raised concerns about security measures, such as dual signatures on checks and key fobs for secure transactions. Susan Splan and Rosalina Trombley from Nevada State Bank addressed these concerns, assuring the board of the bank's security protocols and services. Ms. McIntyre made a motion to approve the transfer of banking accounts to Nevada State Bank. However, certain language was required for the approval, which Dr. Streifel made a motion to include. Ms. McIntyre's motion was retracted through text. All were in favor and the motion passed.

*b. <u>Discussion, Consideration, Review and Possible Approval of Haynie & Company to Perform Professional Financial Audit Services for FY 2024. – NRS 631.190 (For Possible Action)</u>

The board discussed and approved hiring Haney and Company to perform the financial audit for fiscal year 2024, as required by the Legislative Council Bureau. Dr. Lee made a motion to approve the agenda item, with Dr. Johl seconding the motion. All were in favor and motion passed.
